JOE Objectives

JOE has four objectives in view for participants. JOE aims to:



Develop real stewards who know who they are and understand how God has positioned them to influence their countries.

Open the eyes of participants to discover that God's pathway to flourishing is found through fasting, confession, and prayer.



Inspire real stewards in every region and country of the world to hold each other accountable to follow standards together.

Principles of Facilitation

- 1. Pray, pray, pray
- 2. Live in the ambiguity of the questions
- 3. Invite participation from the entire group
- 4. Use open questions to get people talking
- 5. Primarily use stories
- 6. Lead with weakness when appropriate
- 7. There is an agenda
- 8. Be yourself
- 9. Share your own story
- 10. Relax
- 11. Allow the flexible schedule to work for you
- 12. No two JOE experiences are the same
- 13. Keep to the schedule
- 14. Trust the process




